

PROGRAM DETAILS:

- **Dates:** Six weeks, from May 29 to July 11, normally six days a week. One long weekend is free for individual travel.
- **Location:** Castiglione del Lago, a lakeside town in the region of Perugia.
- **Credit:** 6 Umbra Institute credits.
- **Fixed Costs:** \$4975, incl.: airport transfers, orientation and hotel lodging in Perugia, the academic program, housing in Castiglione del Lago, a resident director, use of facilities in Castiglione del Lago, Umbra-sponsored cultural activities, and official transcripts.
- **Unfixed Costs:** ca. \$200 for lab fee (course-pack and field trips); ca. \$415 for meals over the 6 weeks (students cook for themselves most meals, but there are also some free communal meals to which students will be invited); ca. \$1200 for RT airfare, USA-Rome.

- **Giampiero Bevagna** (Umbra Institute) is the instructor of record for both courses.
